Community Integrated Health Conference 2018: Call for Speakers Form

YMCA of the USA is accepting speakers for the **2018 Community Integrated Health (CIH) Conference: Creating a Culture of Health by Integrating Community and Health Care** to be held December 10-12, 2018, at the Washington Hilton Hotel, Washington, DC.

As the first conference of its kind aiming to strengthen the relationships between traditional health care systems and community-based organizations, we are targeting innovation and strategies that take an upstream approach to common issues found in public health, healthcare and community health. This conference will specifically highlight the following community integrated health areas: capacity building, health equity, collaboration, clinic-community integration, privacy laws and health care regulations, or evidence-based health and social service interventions. Your submission will be for one of three 15-minute presentation spots in a plenary session held for each of the focus areas. Speakers will follow each other in a dynamic, engaging and thought-provoking series of short talks; there will be no Q&A session in these plenaries.

This conference will be a unique opportunity to convene and discuss ways to connect the traditional health care system and community-based organizations, in order to help all community members live their healthiest lives. Attendees will have opportunities to discuss the growing field of community integrated health, the value of community-based organizations in health care, and how to create more seamless integration between the health care system and community-based health interventions.

By submitting to be a CIH Speaker, you are pursuing the opportunity to engage an audience of experts and peers with stimulating and innovative thoughts and strategies around key areas of community integrated health. Your recorded 15-minute presentation will become a resource to help practitioners across the country advance the field of community integrated health. You will also be presented with the opportunity to participate as a webinar panelist for the National Community integrated health Collaborative in 2019.

The submission deadline is **11:59PM, June 22, 2018**. After the peer-review process, participants will be informed about selection on July 16, 2018.

Capacity Building – Helping organizations develop and strengthen their infrastructure to effectively deliver, measure, grow, and sustain activities to advance community integrated health.

Health Equity – Advancing conditions in which everyone has the opportunity to attain their full health potential and no one is disadvantaged from achieving this potential because of their social position or other socially determined circumstance.

Collaboration - Utilizing the collective impact model or a similar model to implement policy, system, and environmental changes to achieve community integrated health. The primary focus is on sharing resources, risks, responsibilities, and rewards.

Clinic-Community Integration – Improving and sustaining health by conducting home visits, creating shared spaces for community programs with health practices, and helping connect people to health care exchanges and marketplaces.

Privacy Laws and Health Care Regulations – Ensuring community-based organizations comply with privacy laws and health care regulations.

Evidence-Based Health and Social Service Interventions – Discovering, developing, and disseminating research-tested, high-fidelity community integrated health interventions to improve health.
